

PRIVACY POLICY

PatLoc Safety Systems

1. INTRODUCTION AND SCOPE

PatLoc Safety Systems ("PatLoc," "Company," "we," "us," or "our") respects the privacy of the individuals and entities that access and use our website located at www.patloc.com (the "Site") and our associated services, products, and communications (collectively, the "Services"). This Privacy Policy ("Policy") explains how we collect, use, disclose, retain, and protect information relating to you, and describes the rights and choices available to you with respect to your information.

This Policy applies to all visitors, prospective customers, customers, and other users of the Site and Services, including oilfield operators, service companies, contractors, procurement personnel, and other business professionals who interact with PatLoc in any capacity (collectively, "you" or "users").

By accessing or using the Site, submitting an inquiry, or otherwise engaging with our Services, you acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agree to be bound by this Policy. If you do not agree to the terms of this Policy, you must immediately discontinue your use of the Site and Services.

PatLoc operates primarily in the business-to-business ("B2B") context. The majority of personal information we collect relates to business representatives and professionals acting in their professional capacity. Our Services are not directed to consumers acting in a personal or household capacity, and we do not knowingly collect personal information from individuals under the age of eighteen (18).

2. INFORMATION WE COLLECT

2.1 Information You Provide Directly

We collect personal information that you voluntarily provide to us when you:

Submit a contact form, inquiry, or request for quotation through the Site;

Request product information, technical specifications, or installation support;

Correspond with us by email, telephone, or any other communication channel;

Place an order or enter into a purchase agreement with PatLoc;

Register for any newsletter, product update, or promotional communication;

Respond to surveys or provide feedback regarding our products or Services; or

Otherwise initiate communication with us in any form.

The categories of personal information you may provide include: your full name; job title and professional role; employer name and business address; business email address; business telephone number; billing and shipping address information; and any other information you choose to include in your correspondence or submissions.

2.2 Information Collected Automatically

When you visit the Site, certain technical information is collected automatically by our web infrastructure and hosting systems, including but not limited to:

Internet Protocol ("IP") address and approximate geographic location derived therefrom;

Browser type, version, and language settings;

Operating system and device type;

Referring and exit URLs;

Pages viewed, time spent on pages, and clickstream data;

Date and time of access; and

Other standard web server log data.

This information is collected for the purpose of maintaining the security and integrity of the Site, diagnosing technical issues, and improving Site functionality. We do not use this information for behavioral advertising or cross-site tracking.

2.3 Cookies and Similar Technologies

The Site currently uses functional cookies only — that is, cookies that are strictly necessary for the operation of the Site, including session management and security functions. We do not currently deploy analytics cookies, advertising cookies, or social media tracking pixels.

We reserve the right to implement additional cookies or similar technologies in the future, including analytics tools and live chat functionality. Any such changes will be reflected in an updated version of this Policy and, where required by applicable law, will be accompanied by appropriate consent mechanisms. Please refer to our Cookie Policy for detailed information regarding the types of cookies we use, their purposes, and how to control them.

2.4 Information from Third Parties

We may receive information about you from third-party sources in limited circumstances, such as when a colleague or employer submits your contact information in connection with a business inquiry, or when business contact information is obtained through commercially available B2B data sources. All such information is handled in accordance with this Policy.

3. HOW WE USE YOUR INFORMATION

PatLoc uses personal information we collect for the following purposes, each of which is grounded in a legitimate legal basis as set forth herein:

Responding to Inquiries and Providing Services. We use your contact and business information to respond to your inquiries, provide product information and technical support, process orders, facilitate delivery and installation, and fulfill our contractual obligations to you.

Business Communications. We may use your contact information to send you information relevant to your relationship with PatLoc, including order confirmations, shipping notifications, product updates, safety bulletins, regulatory compliance notices, and service-related communications.

Marketing and Promotional Communications. With your consent, or where permitted by applicable law on the basis of a legitimate business interest, we may send you newsletters, product announcements, industry updates, and promotional materials. You may opt out of marketing communications at any time by following the unsubscribe instructions in our emails or by contacting us directly.

Site Maintenance and Security. We use automatically collected technical information to operate, maintain, and secure the Site, diagnose technical problems, prevent fraud and unauthorized access, and improve Site performance and functionality.

Legal Compliance and Enforcement. We may use your information to comply with applicable laws, regulations, legal process, and enforceable governmental requests; to enforce our Terms and Conditions and other agreements; and to protect the rights, property, and safety of PatLoc, our customers, and the public.

Business Analytics and Improvement. We may use aggregated and de-identified information derived from our users' interactions with the Site to analyze trends, conduct research, and improve our products, services, and marketing strategies. Such aggregated information does not identify you personally.

4. DISCLOSURE OF YOUR INFORMATION

4.1 Service Providers

We may disclose your personal information to third-party service providers who perform functions on our behalf, such as website hosting, IT support, data processing, customer relationship management, email delivery, and payment processing. Such service providers are contractually obligated to use your information only as directed by PatLoc and in accordance with this Policy, and are prohibited from using it for their own independent purposes.

4.2 Future Third-Party Integrations

We may in the future integrate third-party tools and platforms into our Site and Services, including analytics providers, live chat software, customer support platforms, CRM systems, and marketing automation tools. Any such integration will be disclosed in an updated version of this Policy, and where required, we will obtain your consent prior to deploying technologies that collect personal information through the Site.

4.3 Business Transfers

In the event of a merger, acquisition, sale of assets, reorganization, or other corporate transaction involving PatLoc, your information may be transferred to the acquiring or successor entity as part of that transaction. We will notify you of any such transfer by posting a notice on the Site or by other appropriate means, and the successor entity will be required to honor the commitments made in this Policy.

4.4 Legal and Regulatory Disclosures

We may disclose your information without prior notice when we believe in good faith that disclosure is required to: (a) comply with applicable law, regulation, or legal process; (b) respond to a valid subpoena, court order, or government request; (c) protect or enforce our legal rights; (d) investigate or prevent fraud, security incidents, or illegal activity; or (e) protect the personal safety of any person.

4.5 No Sale of Personal Information

PatLoc does not sell, rent, lease, or otherwise transfer your personal information to third parties for monetary consideration or for their independent marketing or advertising purposes. We share information only as described in this Policy.

5. DATA RETENTION

We retain personal information for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes described in this Policy, to maintain accurate business records, and to comply with our legal and contractual obligations. The specific retention period applicable to any given category of information depends on the nature of the information and the purpose for which it was collected.

In general, personal information associated with a customer relationship or active business correspondence is retained for the duration of that relationship and for a period of up to seven (7)

years thereafter, consistent with applicable statutes of limitations and record-keeping requirements under Wyoming and federal law. Information that is no longer required for any legitimate business or legal purpose is securely deleted or anonymized.

6. DATA SECURITY

PatLoc implements and maintains reasonable and appropriate technical and organizational measures designed to protect personal information against unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, destruction, or accidental loss. These measures include, without limitation, encrypted transmission protocols (SSL/TLS), access controls, and secure hosting infrastructure.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, no method of transmission over the Internet or method of electronic storage is completely secure. While we strive to use commercially reasonable means to protect your information, we cannot guarantee its absolute security. In the event of a data breach that is likely to result in a risk to your rights and freedoms, we will notify you as required by applicable law.

7. THIRD-PARTY WEBSITES AND LINKS

The Site may contain links to third-party websites, resources, or platforms that are not operated or controlled by PatLoc. This Policy does not apply to such third-party websites, and we are not responsible for the privacy practices or content of those sites. We encourage you to review the privacy policies of any third-party websites you visit. The inclusion of a link on our Site does not imply endorsement by PatLoc of the linked site or its content.

8. INTERNATIONAL VISITORS AND DATA TRANSFERS

PatLoc is headquartered in Wyoming, United States, and our Site and Services are operated from the United States. If you are accessing the Site from outside the United States, please be aware that your information will be transferred to, processed, and stored in the United States, where data protection laws may differ from those in your jurisdiction.

If you are located in the European Economic Area ("EEA"), the United Kingdom, Switzerland, or another jurisdiction with applicable data transfer restrictions, you acknowledge that your personal information may be transferred to the United States on the basis of your explicit consent, the necessity of performance of a contract with you, or another applicable legal transfer mechanism. We will take appropriate steps to ensure that any such transfers are made in compliance with applicable data protection law.

9. YOUR RIGHTS AND CHOICES

Depending on your jurisdiction of residence, you may have certain rights with respect to your personal information, including:

The right to access the personal information we hold about you and to receive a copy thereof;

The right to request correction or rectification of inaccurate or incomplete personal information;

The right to request deletion of your personal information, subject to certain exceptions;

The right to restrict or object to the processing of your personal information in certain circumstances;

The right to data portability — that is, to receive your personal information in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format;

The right to withdraw consent at any time where processing is based on consent; and

The right to lodge a complaint with a competent supervisory authority.

To exercise any of the rights described above, or to submit a privacy-related inquiry or request, please contact us using the information provided in Section 11 below. We will respond to all verifiable requests within the timeframe required by applicable law. We may need to verify your identity before processing your request and reserve the right to decline requests that are excessive, repetitive, or clearly unfounded.

If you wish to opt out of marketing communications, you may do so at any time by clicking the "unsubscribe" link in any marketing email we send you or by contacting us directly. Please note that even if you opt out of marketing communications, we may still send you transactional or service-related communications.

10. CHILDREN'S PRIVACY

The Site and Services are directed exclusively to business professionals and are not intended for use by individuals under the age of eighteen (18). PatLoc does not knowingly collect personal information from minors. If we become aware that we have inadvertently collected personal information from a minor, we will take prompt steps to delete such information from our records.
